

ORDER


These matters came on for consideration upon the December 2, 2008 occurrence of a status conference in the above-captioned appeals.

After a thorough examination of the instant records, including any pertinent documentation that has been submitted by Appellant and is contained therein, the Board must dismiss the above two captioned appeals. This is because the documentation that Appellant submitted into the record from his own licensed practitioner provides sufficient evidence to demonstrate that Appellant could not perform the essential duties of his position for the time period pertinent to these appeals. It is noted that that Appellant's practitioner did not release Appellant to return to work until a date approximately three weeks after the latest effective date of Appellant's instant Orders of Involuntary Disability Separation.

Wherefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the instant appeals be **DISMISSED** for the reasons set forth above, pursuant to R.C. 124.03.


