
ORDER


This matter came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeal.



REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This matter came on for consideration on September 25, 2009, pursuant to a record hearing scheduled in the above-referenced matter at 10:00 a.m. on that date. Appellee appeared before this Board at that time and was represented by Reno J. Oradini, Jr., Assistant Prosecuting Attorney. Appellant failed to appear and Appellee moved to dismiss this appeal.
