REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:


This matter came on for consideration on March 4, 2010. Appellee appeared and was represented by James A. Hogan and Rema A. Ina, Assistant Attorneys General.

Several weeks ago, Appellant Craddolph's son called this Board to inform the Board of Appellant Craddolph's death and stated he wanted to proceed with the case. He was informed that he would have to send in the proper documentation and appear at the hearing. Notice of the hearing was mailed to Appellant Craddolph's address on file with the Board on October 23, 2009 and her son was verbally told of the hearing date. No one on behalf of Appellant Craddolph appeared for the record hearing.

Appellee moved to dismiss this appeal for a failure of anyone to appear on Appellant Craddolph's behalf to further her appeal.

I find notice was properly served on Appellant on October 23, 2009, by regular mail, and no good cause has been shown for the failure of anyone to appear on behalf of Appellant Craddolph.

I **RECOMMEND** the Appellee's motion be **GRANTED** and the appeal be **DISMISSED**.
