





**REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION**

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This matter came on for consideration on April 2, 2012. Appellee was represented by Timothy M. Miller and Matthew J. Karam, Assistant Attorneys General. Appellant failed to appear and Appellee moved to dismiss this appeal.

I find notice was properly served on Appellant on January 12, 2012, by regular mail, and no good cause has been shown for Appellant's failure to appear. Further, it appears that Appellant was granted a disability retirement benefit by the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System. As such, there no longer appears to be a justiciable issue before the Board in this case.

Therefore, I respectfully **RECOMMEND** that the State Personnel Board of Review **GRANT** Appellee's motion and **DISMISS** the instant appeal for Appellant's failure to appear, pursuant to O.A.C. 124-11-19 and for the lack of a justiciable issue before the Board in this case, pursuant to R.C. 124.03.
