
ORDER


This matter came on for consideration on the review of the extant record by the Full Board. The case was initially developed by the assigned Administrative Law Judge. Further, on January 24, 2012, the Full Board issued a Procedural Order / Supplementation of the Record to clarify when Appellant received notice of the instant abolishment/layoff. The parties were instructed in that Procedural Order to file respective detailed responses with this Board on or before February 8, 2012. On February 8, 2012, Appellee timely and fully filed its response. However, to date, Appellant has not filed Appellant's response.


O.A.C. 124-11-13 (B) provides that the Board may dismiss a case for a party's failure to comply with the terms of a Procedural Order. Here, Appellant has failed to comply with the filing requirements set forth in the afore-mentioned Procedural Order. Further, it now seems clear that Appellant was untimely in his filing of the instant appeal.

Wherefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the instant appeal be **DISMISSED** for untimely filing, pursuant to R.C. 124.328 and for Appellant's failure to file a response to the Full Board's Procedural Order, pursuant to R.C. 124-11-13 (B).


